Open notepad and type the following statement as given below:

```
Windows Registry Editor Version 5.00  
[HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SYSTEM\CurrentControlSet\Services\USBSTOR]  
"Start"=dword:00000004
```

Once the statement written in the notepad successfully, save the script to **Usbdetection.Reg** to any location of the hard drive, once the file is saved just double click on the file in order to Disable USB Detection from the Operating system.

DISABLE WRITE PROTECT

Open notepad and type the following statement as given below:

```
Windows Registry Editor Version 5.00  
[HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\System\CurrentControlSet\Control\StorageDevicePolicies]  
"WriteProtect"=dword:00000001
```

Once the statement written in the notepad successfully, save the script to **WriteProtect.Reg** to any location of the hard drive, once the file is saved just double click on the file in order to apply the Write Protection.
